

## 6. Moderator's Guide / Research Questions

Below is a moderator's guide containing the specific research questions.

<b>Section &amp; Timing</b>	<b>Total Timing: 60 minutes</b>
<b>Intro 1 minutes</b>	<i>Hello! My name is Susan Ford and I am a user researcher working on a project that looks at how people share, organize, and access photographs and video recordings of important moments so family and friends can easily find and enjoy them. Thank you for taking the time today to answer a few questions about how you share and organize photos and videos. Before we get started, I'd like to go over the consent form with you and answer any questions you might have about this session.</i>
<b>Consent Form 2 minute</b>	<i>This is a copy of the consent form we sent you prior to this session. It basically says that I will be recording our sessions and taking notes; that participation in this interview is completely voluntary; that your name and other information will be confidential; that you are free to ask any questions and withdraw from the session at any time, and that any information pertaining to new designs, software, etc will not be divulged outside of this session. Do you have any questions about anything in the consent form? If you agree to the statements made in the consent form, you can go ahead and state "I agree to the consent form".</i>
<b>Overview of Session 2 minutes</b>	<i>During this session, I will be asking you a series of questions regarding how you share, organize, and access photos and videos. We're interested in knowing your thoughts and feelings about how you do these specific jobs: what you like/dislike; what your needs are; what works for you and what doesn't; and hear what your suggestions are to make these tasks easier and more intuitive.</i>

	<p><i>Before we begin, I'd just like to go over a few things with you about our session today.</i></p> <p><i>Like I had mentioned with the consent form, I will be taking notes and recording a video of our session. This will help me to be able to remember things that you said or did during the session. The video will also allow me to go back and catch something I don't have in my notes or if I need clarification.</i></p> <p><i>As you show me how you perform specific tasks with your photos and videos, I'll ask you to "think aloud". This will allow me to know what you're thinking as you use the application and will help me to understand what can be done to make the tasks easier to accomplish and fit your needs.</i></p> <p><i>There are no right or wrong answers. I want you to tell me what you like or dislike about the process so we have a better understanding on how to make photo and video organization and sharing easier for you. You won't hurt my feelings if you tell me what you truly think.</i></p> <p><i>We aren't here to evaluate you. We want to learn how this process works for you and how we can design it better to support you. So feel free to comment on any aspect of the applications that you currently use: how it looks, how it works, and if it fits your needs.</i></p> <p><i>Your name and information will be kept strictly confidential. Anything you say during this interview will not be associated to your name.</i></p> <p><i>If you need to take a break at any time, please let me know. Our session should last 30-45 minutes.</i></p> <p><i>Do you have any questions before we proceed?</i></p>
